DCL 2019 – Rules of the Futsal Women draw	
1	The draw ceremony will take place on Sunday 28 th October 2018 in Stuttgart, Germany. The draw will start at 6 p.m.
2	The representatives in the draw will be assisted with 2 members of the DCL Executive Committee.
3	12 clubs have qualified for this competition. The title-holder, MKSN Mazowsze Warszawa (Poland), have qualified automatically as well as the organising host, GSG Stuttgart.
4	Pot 1 will consist of the title-holder MKSN Mazowsze Warszawa (Poland) plus the 2 best countries in the DCL Coefficient, which are Germany and Italy for this competition.
5	The 11 teams will be divided into 3 groups of 4-4-3 teams each for the Group Stages.
6	The 3 clubs are first placed in groups A1, B1 and C1, then the 3 clubs are placed in groups as A2, B2 and C2, and so on.
6	No club from the same country will be placed in the same group. If a club is drawn out and there is a clash of two clubs from one country, then the club drawn out will be moved to the next group. A, B and then C is the order of sequence. E.g. if a team is drawn out for B2 and there is a clash (2 clubs from 1 country), then that club moves to C2. So, the next team drawn will be placed as B2. If there is a clash of 2 clubs from 1 country in the last position of the group, e.g. team drawn out for C2, then B2 and C2 switch places. If switching B2 and C2 does not work, then C2 switches with A2, etc. The same approach applies for each group.
7	If a team withdraws from the competition before the draw is made, then the last Group (i.e. Group C) is reduced to 3 teams. Group B would be the next group to be reduced to 3 teams if another team withdraws, and so on.
8	After the draw, the Technical Director Futsal will issue the official schedule of the matches within 2 hours. Any questions must be directed to the Technical Director Futsal.
