



Deaf Champions League Women Football 7x7 Challenge Cup

Football Summary Rules

1	It is strictly forbidden to use players from other Clubs.
2	Up to 15 players on the registration list. Up to 12 players on the Match Sheet per match + up to 4 Team Officials.
3	Players Pass is required for the whole DCL competition.
4	A representative of the team must give the players' passes and completed Match Sheet <u>45 minutes before</u> each match to a <u>DCL Representative at the allocated pitch</u> . Match Sheet write in BLOCK CAPITALS . If the club does not hand in their match sheet on time a fine of 10€ will be imposed by DCL.
5	All Group matches – 2 x 35 minutes.
6	Half Time: 10 mins
7	All teams will play each other once in the Group.
8	Group matches – Win = 3 points. Draw = 1 point. Lose = 0 points.
9	If the colours of the two teams lead to confusion in a match, the 'away' team must make a change. The change can be a combination of first-choice kit and reserve kit.
10	<u>All players' equipment must comply with the Football Laws</u> . ALL players MUST have shin guards and NO jewellery allowed. No shin guard, then the player cannot play in the match. If wrong equipment during the match, the Referee shall caution the player.
11	Number of players: All matches cannot start or continue with less than 6 players on the field of play (football 7x7).
12	There are NO Offsides during the matches.
13	Substitutions: The use of <u>Return Substitutions</u> will be used for this competition. All players listed on the Match Sheet can play and be substituted. Any player who comes off (is substituted) may come back onto the field of play at any time during the match. All substitutions must be made in accordance with the current IFAB Laws of the Game (Law 3 – Substitution procedure). A player who has been dismissed during the match may not be replaced or take any further part in the match.
14	All substitutes must wear a warm up bib during the matches. Important: each club is obliged to bring their own warm up bibs in two different colours for the substitutes. If the club borrows the DCL warm up bibs and does not hand in the DCL bibs after the match a fine of 20€ each match will be imposed by DCL.
15	A player who is sent off the field of play (Red card or 2 Yellow cards) is suspended for the next match. The Control and Disciplinary Body (CDB) is entitled to augment any punishment. For very serious offences the punishment can also be extended for the rest of the competition.

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16	After <u>two</u> cautions (Yellow cards) in different matches the player is automatically suspended for the next match.
17	<p>Payment of the fine (sanction) for cards received by a player in a match:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Red card: 20€ - Yellow card: 10€ - Double yellow card (yellow + yellow card): 15€ <p>The economic sanctions must be paid before the next match to DCL. If the club do not pay this economic sanction, the player cannot play in any match.</p>
18	<p>Group Ranking of Clubs in the simple Group.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Greatest number of points in the Group; <p>If two or more teams are equal with points, then we use;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Most points between the teams concerned; 2. Goal difference between the teams concerned; 3. Most goals scored between the teams concerned; 4. Goal difference in all the Group matches; 5. Most goals scored in all the Group matches; 6. Fair Play record (looking at the cautions first then the sending offs) between the team concerned; 7. Drawing of lots by the Deaf Champions League.
19	Teams which field a player wearing an amplification device will have that player suspended for a minimum of 1 match in the competition. During the match, the guilty player will be dismissed from the Field of Play (i.e. red card). A fine of 100€ will be imposed on the offending club and the match result shall stand.
20	Top Goals Scorer Award: The goals scored in all the Group matches will be counted.
21	For any matters not covered in the present regulations the Technical Committee make the appropriate decision.
